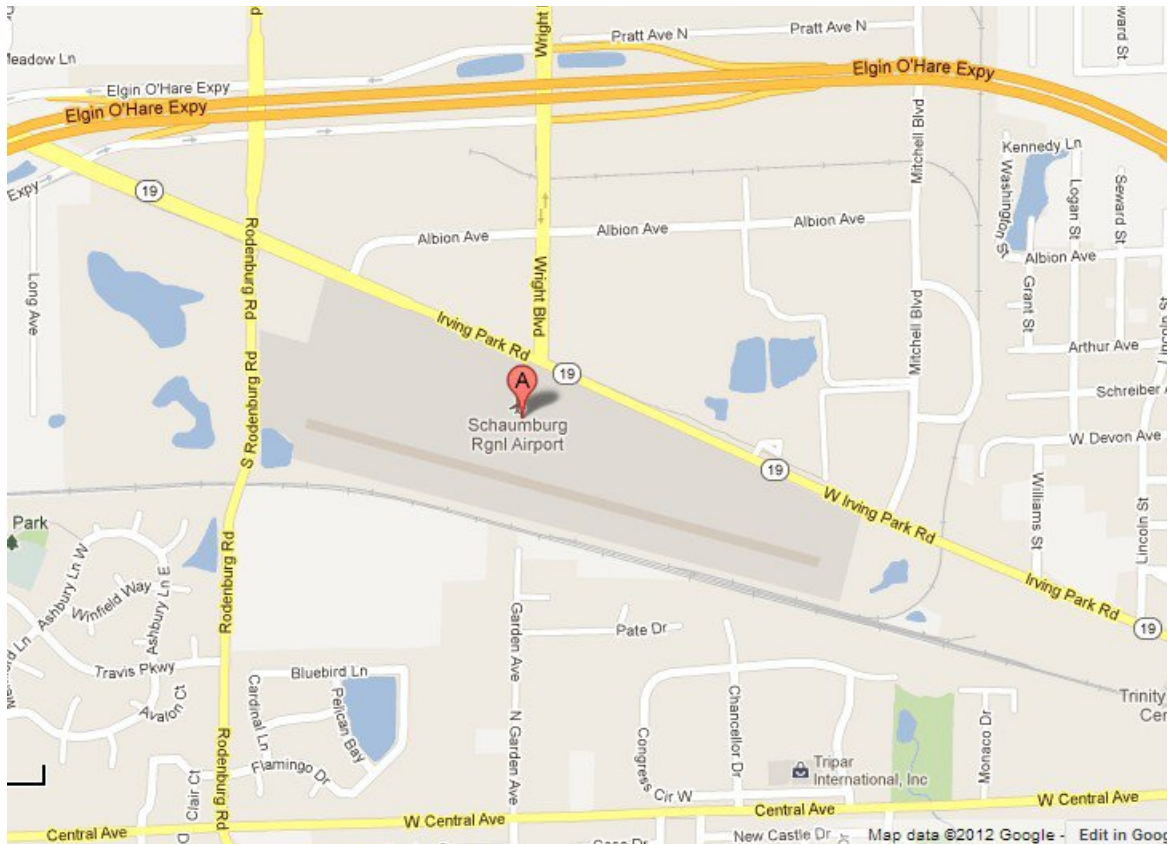
interested in borrowing them. They are available during meetings as well. If you have any tools you would like us to have, please contact us or mention it at the meetings.
