

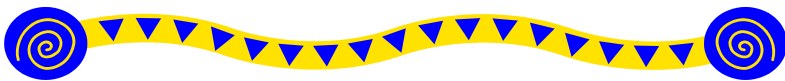
Puzzle Peace United

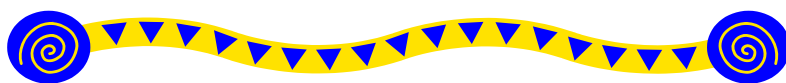
Bowling and Golf Events!! Huge Success!!
