- We specialize in Severe Emotional Behavior Disorders
- ADHD, Reactive Attachment Disorder, Mild Retardation, Down syndrome, Mild to Moderate Autism Spectrum Disorders, Bi-Polar, Oppositional Defiant Disorder, and other Mood or Emotional Behavior Disorders
- Siblings
- Any child whether special needs or not in need of care

• **Who Does Not Qualify?**

- Medically Fragile
- Sexually Abusive Children
- Suicidal or Homicidal Children
- Children with a history of harming animals
